\$360K hatchery capacity training program

Minister for Primary Industries Niall Blair announced a commitment of \$4million to NSW Farmers Association. SOCo, partnering with NSW Farmers Association will develop capacity of commercial hatcheries through training, as well as further developing the breeding program.



Family breeding

Condition, resilience, disease resistance and growth are targeted in the Sydney Rock Oyster family breeding program. DPI Fisheries, CSIRO geneticists, and SOCo are developing families, expected to be commercially available in 2017. Over 40 families were produced at DPI Fisheries hatchery Oct 2015. 2016 families will be produced late this year.

Hatchery Hub

On the ground consultation by shellfish expert Jonathan Bilton Athair Aquaculture identified ways to optimize operations in participating hatcheries. Industry workshops at Port Stephens Fisheries Institute and Narooma Fishing club discussed hatchery operations the latest performance data on SRO families.
